Our progress...



Thank you to everyone who completed our survey this year. The feedback we receive is crucial to ensure that we continually reflect and improve on what we do and what we offer our students, staff, parents and the wider community.

Our role is not only to provide an outstanding education to our young people but also develop their character so that when they leave College they are ready to face the challenges that they will meet in the world and make it better. Building our ability to take risks, knowing what to do when we don't know what to do and believing that we can is all part of this. Throughout the year, we have talked regularly with students about the need to move more, enjoy fresh air and eat well; in a whole College assembly, our Head Girl presented research from Dr William Bird supporting this.

Furthermore, we are improving our campus to make our environment increasingly biophilic. While this work will remain a focus over the coming year, it is pleasing to see that 91% of respondents agree or strongly agree that JCG enhances students' understanding of how to develop positive mental health and sustain a healthy lifestyle. This is an increase of 5% from last year. Additionally, 70% agree or strongly agree that we develop self-confidence, self-esteem and resilience in our students showing an increase of 6%.

We have also tried to improve both our impact on the environment and our protection of it. Although this area is not yet considered outstanding and we know we have more to do, 75% of respondents believe we are protecting the environment and we are pleased that this has increased by 9% since last year.

81% of those surveyed believe that the College is secure and safe, and we know that this is a 6% decrease compared to last year. We are working hard to improve site security which includes updating our CCTV and electronic access systems.

In our survey, 72% acknowledge that we give regular feedback on student work. Although good, this is not yet outstanding and so is a priority for the year ahead. Our conference this year was opened by Professor Dylan Wiliam who spoke passionately about formative assessment, and we believe that this reinforced our teachers' skills in assessment for learning. Similarly, 70% agree or strongly agree that homework supports learning. Whilst our students do not always immediately see the value of homework in supporting their learning, we know that it is vital and mastering the ability to work independently outside of a school setting, whilst revisiting and retrieving knowledge acquired in the classroom, is crucial.

We will continue to check that work set is valuable and purposeful and provide opportunities for students to act on feedback.
